# Pensacola State College Scholarship Newslefter

### Pensacola State Scholarships

PSC awards scholarships based on academic merit, leadership, school and community service, financial need, and other criteria. To qualify for consideration, applicants must submit a completed Pensacola State scholarship application and all required documentation online at http://www.pensacolastate.edu/fi nancial-aid. Please note, applications are academic year specific. A new application must be submitted for each academic vear to be considered for a scholarship.

#### Academic Merit Scholarship

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or resident alien. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA on all high school, college or vocational credits and must plan to enroll on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 college credits or 450 clock hours). Recipients must maintain full-time enrollment and a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.

#### Foundation Scholarships

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen, have a minimum 2.0-2.5 cumulative grade point average on all high school, college, or vocational credits, and be enrolled in six or more credits. Other specific criteria may apply.

If you have already submitted an online application for fall 2016, that application is valid for spring and summer of 2017.

#### **Application Deadlines**

Pensacola State scholarship applications and any requisite academic transcripts are accepted throughout the specified academic year but are subject to deadlines established for each term. Once an application is submitted, it will be reviewed for eligibility for each term thereafter for that academic year. The deadline for the **2016-2017 Spring Term is:** 

Tuesday, November 1, 2016 by 11:59 pm.

1	Florida Financial Aid Application for Students	An online application for state-funded financial aid programs is available at www.FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org . This application can be completed online and is used for a variety of scholarships offered by the State of Florida. 2	P.E.O. Educational Loan Fund	The P.E.O. Education Loan fund offers low interest (2%) loans to women who desire higher education and are in need of financial assistance. Applicant must be a high school graduate (or equivalent), have a credit score of at least 625, and be within two years (but not less than four months) of completing her course of study. Two cosigners are required and each must have at least a 650 credit score. For additional information contact Carol Hester, Chair, P.E.O. Education Loan Fund, at (850) 791-6899.
3	P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education	This is a need based grant for women students. To qualify a student must have had at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student during her adult life, and must be within 24 months of completing her educational goal (academic or technical). Applications will be considered no more than four months prior to the beginning of the term for which the grant is requested. For further information, contact Marian Wernicke, Chair, P.E.O. 5	Fellows Foundation	Scholarship loans are available to students who are residents of Northwest Florida studying medicine, theology, and professional nursing and medical technology, and other select programs. Students must also have a GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. 7	Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections Scholarship	Applicants must meet the following criteria: be either a political science/public or business administration or journalism/mass communication major; citizen of the United States; a resident of Florida for two years preceding the academic year for which application is made; be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in a senior college or university in Florida; have finished two years of junior college or undergraduate work prior to enrollment for the term for which the application is made; demonstrate financial need; have maintained a "C" average or above for the previous year; and <b>be a registered voter</b> . The application will be <b>available online after December 1</b> at http://www.myfloridaelections.com/.
