- 1. An academic year is defined at 900 clock hours/32 weeks. Tuition and fees are based on 15 vocational credits x 30 hours/16 weeks X 2 payment periods. The College tuition is \$85.74 per vocational credit for in-state students. For Alabama residents the College fee is \$95.74 per vocational credit. For Out-of-State, the rate is \$342.96 per vocational credit.
- 2. Books, equipment and supplies based on average costs for new, used, rental, or digital books and required equipment and supplies per semester for full-time enrollment. For \leq \$900 ÷ 12 X 5 = \$375
- 3. The average living expenses budget for a student living with parents is calculated as \$450 a month for nine (9) months, plus \$1,572 for food. The average room and board budget for students not living with parents is calculated as \$904 a month for room and board for nine (9) months plus \$2,090 for food.
- 4. Transportation based on 30 miles round trip X 4 days per week X 32 weeks at 58.5 cents per mile (rounded down).
- 5. Miscellaneous personal expenses based on estimated average expenses for personal hygiene items, clothing, recreation and entertainment.
