

## FINANCIAL AID DISBURSEMENTS DATES

<p>Student aid will be credited to your student account. After charges for tuition, fees and books are paid and you have begun attendance in each of your courses, any remaining credit balances you are entitled to receive for enrollment related living expenses will be transferred to your Higher One Account. <b>REMEMBER, THE BALANCE YOU WILL RECEIVE IS BASED ON THE COURSES YOU HAVE BEGUN ATTENDING.</b> You may receive additional funds later in the term if you have late session courses (Sessions C and/or D). Higher One will notify you by Pirate Email when those funds are deposited to your account.</p>	
<p><b>PELL Grant*</b> The college credits your grant funds to your school account.</p>	<p>Beginning the fourth week of the semester</p>
<p><b>Federal Stafford Direct Loan Program #</b> FDLP / PLUS loans are credited to your OneCard account. You will not receive a check from your lender.</p>	<p>FDLP funds are received at the College a minimum of 30 days after the first day of the semester but never more than three (3) days prior to being credited to student accounts. Loan funds are not available to purchase books. Enrollment eligibility is verified prior to EACH disbursement.</p>
<p><b>Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)</b></p>	<p>After the midpoint in the term.</p>
<p><b>Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG)</b> <b>Florida Student Assistance Grants – Certificate Education (FSAG-CE)</b></p>	<p>Fall and Spring terms only After the midpoint in the term.</p>
