1. Complete and submit the Pensacola State College application (\$30) for general admission. Have your high school and college transcripts sent to Pensacola State College. This will generate your Pirate e-mail account, which will be the primary method of contacting you regarding your admission status. Please check your Pirate e-mail account on a weekly basis. Your e-mail address is located in Spyglass account; it is in red near the top of the page.
2. For help with college admissions, contact the Milton campus at (850) 484-4410, Pensacola campus at (850) 484-1600, Century Center at (850) 471-4622, South Santa Rosa Center at (850) 471-4630 or Warrington campus at (850) 484-2270.
3. Complete this application for health-related programs and submit it to the admissions office at any Pensacola State College campus. Health-related applications are forwarded to the Health Program Admissions Office on the Warrington Campus. You may also fax this application to (850) 484-2375.
4. Each program has an information packet on the healthprograms website at: www.pensacolastate.edu/healthprograms. Pay particular attention to the admissions requirements. Contact Health Program Admissions Office for questions regarding admission requirements, (850) 484-2210. To become a qualified candidate, you must complete all admissions requirements listed in the information packet.
5. Keep your address and phone number current with the college. You may update your contact information via your Spyglass account.
6. Complete test requirements for the health-related program you've selected. Tests with fees are: HOBET (\$30), LPN (\$25), and HESI (\$70). The TABE, Nelson Denny, Health-Related Math and Algebra tests are free. The PERT is also free; however, if you choose to re-test the fee is \$10. All tests have a waiting period for retesting, check with the testing department for the current wait times. Call the Testing and Assessment Office to schedule your tests: Pensacola campus (850) 484-1987 or Warrington campus (850) 484-1076.
7. Upon acceptance to a health-related program, you will be required to undergo a criminal background check and a drug test. Pending successful results of these two tests, you may continue in your chosen program.
8. Upon acceptance to a health-related program, you will be required to submit to the college provided physical and your immunization records. You are responsible for all fees associated with the immunizations and physical.
9. Seats in health programs are based on a 'first-completed, first-seated' system. Once you have met all admissions requirements for your program(s), you are moved to the candidate list. Candidates for the next program start date are selected in candidacy date order.
