Student Ambassadors selected for the 2017-2018 year will serve summer 2017, fall 2017 and spring 2018. Additionally, Ambassadors will be required to attend weekly meetings in conjunction with the Ambassador program each semester.

## **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

All Student Ambassador candidates must:

- Graduate from a Baldwin, Escambia or Santa Rosa county high school in 2017.
- Admitted to Pensacola State College (Completed admissions application & \$30 application fee paid)
- Commit to summer, fall and spring terms
- Attend weekly meetings and training sessions

## APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE

- Two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a High School teacher or guidance counselor.
- Unofficial high school transcript (Electronic copies preferred)
- Current Resume
