Definition: This measure shows the number of completers and the number of leavers from the 2010-11 AA2 follow up file with the college supplemental placement data matched with the 2011 CIP Tables. The number of completers and leavers that were matched are displayed as the "number in pool". The display also shows the number a percentage of students who completed and were placed into an occupation related to their instruction (which includes the military or continuing their education), and the number and percentage of students who left and were placed into an occupation related to their instruction.

Number in Pool is defined as the number of records with useable match data. It excludes records with exceptionalities without positive outcome data.

Non_Resident Aliens, undeterminable and unusable data, and those reported as incarcerated.

Number Placed is defined as the number of records deemed training related by virtue of related work, continuing education, or found in the military.
