

The Motorcycle Safety Foundation Basic Rider course is a complete course of instruction for those who wish to develop safe street-riding skills and obtain a motorcycle endorsement. This 2-day course includes classroom instruction combined with motorcycle riding activities on an approved training range. The riding skills evaluation and the written exam will need to be successfully completed to receive a Basic Rider Course Completion Card. Course handbook, insurance, helmet and motorcycle are provided. Students must pass the class to add the motorcycle endorsement to their license.

FAQ

Motorcycle Safety, sure, but what is an Endorsement, and do I need one?

To ride a motorcycle legally in Florida you must have the words "Motorcycle Also" or "Motorcycle Only" on your driver license. You can only add that endorsement by completing a 15 hour motorcycle safety course. If you ride any motorcycle, scooter or trike with an engine at least 50cc or larger, you need the endorsement.

If I've been riding for a long time, do I need the class?

Yes, it's the only way to get the endorsement added. You will build your skills even if you already know how to ride, so don't worry...you'll have fun too.

What if I have an out of state license?

You can still take our class. After your class, you can ask your home state if they will add an endorsement with your completion card, or exchange that license for a Florida one with the endorsement on it.

What Happens After the Courseis Complete?

To successfully complete the course, you must be successful on both a 25 question multiple choice evaluation and a 5 part Skill Evaluation on the motorcycle. Upon completion of the course, your information will be entered into the DMV portal with the satisfactory requirements. The Plan

- Stagger gymnastics classes in order to accommodate cleaning in between classes and to accommodate traffic in the building.
- Limit recreational and preschool classes at PSC so there are no more than 18 recreational and preschool students in the building at any time.
- Ask that parents not stay, if at all possible, during classes.
- Separate seating and create seating blocks in the spectator area to accommodate social distancing.
- Place colored squares on the floor at six foot intervals at the beginning of classes and ask that students stay on those squares during warm-ups. Often times, we have stations set up that are six feet apart, so social distancing is encouraged. The size of the equipment provides the ability to social distance.
- Close locker rooms and limit bathroom goers to one at a time. We will also close off the water fountain and request that students bring their own water to class.
- Monitor our employees for symptoms and we will place signage that those with symptoms should not participate.
- Update waiver to add COVID-19 protection for us and the college, indicating that there is always a risk involved in being in public of catching an infectious disease.
- Trained staff in the cleaning procedures.

This is an extremely challenging time. We are doing our best to continue to be safe and still have some sort of semi-normal environment. We will continue to monitor the situation and if things change, we will address it. We also look to PSC for guidance at this time with their policies and procedures."
