1. An academic year is defined at 900 clock hours/32 weeks. Tuition and fees are based on fifteen (15) vocational credits x 30 hours/16 weeks X 2 payment periods. The College tuition is \$85.74 per vocational credit for in-state students. For Alabama residents the College fee is \$95.74 per vocational credit. For Out-of-State, the rate is \$342.96 per vocational credit. Board approved June 2022.
2. Books, equipment and supplies based on average costs for new, used, rental, or digital books and required equipment and supplies per semester for full-time enrollment.
3. The average room and board budget for a student living with parents is calculated as \$350 a month for nine (9) months. The average room and board budget for students not living with parents is calculated as \$700 a month for room and board plus \$150 for utilities to equal an estimated cost of \$850 a month for nine (9) months.
4. Transportation based on 30 miles round trip X 4 days per week X 32 weeks at 54 cents per mile (rounded down).
5. Miscellaneous personal expenses based on estimated average expenses for personal hygiene items, clothing, recreation and entertainment.
