



P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education Scholarship

Maximum Grant: \$3,000

Established in 1973, the P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education Scholarship (P.C.E.) provides need-based grants to women in the United States and Canada whose education has been interrupted and who find it necessary to return to school to support themselves and/or their families.

This scholarship is grant-in-aid for education-related expenses such as tuition, books, supplies, transportation, childcare while in class, required uniforms, testing fees, and equipment/tools.

Who should apply?

Female students are eligible to apply for P.C.E. provided that they:

- Are a resident of the United States or Canada and living or studying in the U.S. or Canada for the entire course of study.
- Are enrolled in a technical or degree program, not a doctoral degree program.
- Have had at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime in their adult life.
- Are within 24 consecutive months of completing an educational program.
- Are enrolled in an educational program which, at the conclusion, will lead to employment or job advancement.
- Have need.
