

FINANCIAL AID, VETERAN SERVICES, AND SCHOLARSHIPS PETITION FOR INDEPENDENT STATUS – 2021-2022

This form must be completed every academic year

The U.S. Congress and Department of Education determine the criteria which identifies a student as dependent or independent of their parents for financial aid purposes. To automatically be considered independent for federal financial aid for the 2021-2022 year, students must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Be born before January 1, 1998
- Be legally married as of the date the FAFSA is filed
- Be working on a masters or doctorate degree
- Be active duty military or a veteran
- Provide 51% or more support for a biological or adopted child
- Provide 51% of more support for a legal dependent (such as a legal ward awarded custody through the family court system)
- Have been in foster care, orphaned by both parents, or legally declared a ward of the court after the age of 13
- Have been in a legal guardianship at the time they reached the age of majority (18 in Florida, 19 in Alabama)
- Have been legally emancipated by a family court
- Have been determined to be homeless or self-supporting or at-risk of homelessness as determined by a high school or district homeless liaison, HUD, or the director of a homeless youth center or transitional living program on or after July 1, 2020

If the student does not meet of the following criteria, they may appeal their dependency status for the following reason(s):

- Parental abandonment (generally 2 or more years)
- A documented abusive home situation (physical, psychological, sexual)
- Incarceration of the both parents
- Incarceration of the custodial parent and the non-custodial parent meets one of the above criteria (i.e., abuse, abandonment)

The federal government has identified the below listed conditions, which, individually or in combination with one another, do not qualify as valid extenuating circumstances for which a student may appeal their dependency status. Appeals submitted for the following condition(s) will be automatically denied:

- Parents refuse to contribute to the student's education
- Parents are unwilling to provide information on the FAFSA or for verification
- Parents do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes
- Parents live away from the student or in a foreign capacity
- Student does not live with parent(s)
- Student demonstrates total self-sufficiency

You, the student, must provide three (3) letters of support from community members who have specific knowledge of the circumstances which have resulted in your belief that you are independent of your parents. A combination of letters and official court documents may also be submitted to support your appeal. Acceptable letters of support are from such sources as clergy, social workers, high school counselors, professional counselors, lawyers, teachers, etc. Letters must be on official letterhead OR must be notarized. Letters should include the length of the relationship with the student, current contact information* (address, phone, email) and, how, in their professional capacity, the person is aware of the student's family situation. Family members or friends are not considered third-party. Letters from family members or friends may be provided to support your appeal, however, they cannot be used in lieu of third-party supporting documentation.
