The Works Cited list citation formats shown here are based on guidelines from the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, 8th edition, 2016. Additional MLA format guides are available at <http://library.pensacolastate.edu/index.php/cite-your-sources/>.

For the Works Cited page, **alphabetize** the list of sources by the first word of the entry, **double space each entry**, and **place a hanging indent** for any line after the first line of each entry.

Include as many of the following core elements as possible in the order shown and with the punctuation shown:

1. Author.
2. Title of source. (section, chapter)
3. Title of container,
4. Other contributors (editors, translators, etc.),
5. Version,
6. Number,
7. Publisher,
8. Publication date,
9. Location.

10. Title of second container,
11. Other contributors (editors, translators, etc.),
12. Version,
13. Number,
14. Publisher,
15. Publication date,
16. Location.

EXAMPLES:

Citing an entire ebook:

Author's Name(s). *Title of the Book (italicized)*. version/edition (an e-book is consider a version, so specify EPUB, Kindle, etc.), publisher, date. *Name of the Database (italicized)*.

Ventrone, Jillian, and Andrew Hollis. *From the Air Force to College: Transitioning From the Service to Higher Education*. EPUB ed., Rowman & Littlefield Publisher, 2016. *eBook Collection (EBSCOhost)*.

Citing an ebook from Google books: (Cite only as a web resource if some or all of the text of the book is available online.)

Rolf, David. *The Fight for Fifteen: The Right Wage for a Working America*, assisted by Corrie Watterson Bryant, The New Press, 2016, *Google Books*.

[Do not include a URL after the database name unless your instructor requires you to do so.]

Article/Chapter from an Anthology or Collection of Works in eBook format:

Author's Name (of the section being cited). "Title of the Section/Chapter being cited." *Title of the Anthology/Collection (in italics)*, Other contributors, Publisher, Publication Date, Page number(s) of cited piece. *Name of the Database (italicized)*.

Woodard, Loretta G. "Lucy A. Delaney." *African American Autobiographers: A Sourcebook*, edited by Emmanuel S. Nelson., Greenwood, 2002, pp. 79-82. *ABC-CLIO eBook Collection*.

Articles from Encyclopedias and Other Electronic Reference Sources on the Web Available through Pensacola State College Library Databases:

These articles were originally published in a print publication and then reproduced in a library subscription database.

"Stephen King." *Biography in Context*. Originally published in *Encyclopedia of World Biography*, Gale, 1998.

Heller, Terry. "A Worn Path." *Literary Reference Center Plus*. Originally published in *Masterplots II: Short Story Series*, rev. ed., Salem, 2004, pp.1-2.

Always check with your instructor to be sure that you are citing your references correctly.
