

## **Library Quick Guide:**

## Go to the PSC Library homepage at http://pensacolastate.edu/edu




Click on the **Articles and Journals** tab, then on **Getting Started with Databases**. For more databases, click on the *A-Z list of Databases* or *Databases by Subject*.



Getting Started with Databases presents a selected list of databases, arranged by Subject. Click on the Database Name. For most classes, we recommend the database, Academic Search Complete found under Multidisciplinary / General

Purpose Databases.






Login Information: To log in, use the drop down menu to select Pensacola State College. Your Borrower ID is the 14 digit barcode number from the Pensacola State ID card. The PIN is the last 4 digits of your Social Security number. The 14 digit barcode number is also available to you in SpyGlass. You may also use login through the PSC Library link in Canvas!


A second browser window will open with the database search screen. Enter search terms into the search box.

Watch for check boxes for Full Text and Scholarly (Peer Reviewed)

articles. All databases do not look the same.



Different databases provide different search options. Enter **keywords**, not entire statements. Use quotes around words to create a phrase.


