


# Library Quick Guide: Find Health, Nursing, Medical Articles in PSC Library Databases



From the Library home page at <http://www.pensacolastate.edu/library/>, mouse over the **Articles and Journals** tab. Click on **Databases by Subject**.




Click on the plus sign next to the **Health & Medicine** heading to see the list of databases the College provides.



*Medline with Full Text* provides ways to search for *evidence-based medicine (EBM)* and to search subsets, such as Nursing and Bioethics. Other health-related databases include *CINAHL Plus with Full Text* and *Nursing Collection (OVID)*.



**Login Information:** To log in, use the drop down menu to select Pensacola State College. The **Borrower ID** is the **14 digit barcode number** from the **Pensacola State ID card**. The PIN is the last 4 of the SSN#. The barcode number appears *in Spyglass as your Fla. State library number*.



A second browser window will open with the database search screen. Enter search terms into the search box. **Look for check box for Full Text**, and scroll down to check **Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) articles**. All databases do not look the same. Some health databases offer additional limiting features.



Click the subject **Health & Medicine** to see the list of databases that contain health and/or medical information. The one named **Health & Nursing (EBSCO)** searches these databases simultaneously: CINAHL, Health Source Nursing/Academic Edition, Medline, and PscyARTICLES.
