The purpose of this policy is to protect Pensacola State College employees and students from the health hazards of secondhand smoke and to implement the requirements of the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act. Secondhand smoke may come from either smoking cigarettes or vaping.

Smoking is strictly prohibited in all “enclosed indoor workplaces” as such areas are defined in the Act, including all buildings owned or operated by the College and the offices, hallways, waiting rooms, restrooms, dining areas, break rooms, elevators, classrooms, and community rooms located in such buildings. Smoking is also strictly prohibited within fifty feet (50’) of college building entryway, HVAC air intake vent, open window, or other opening to any building. For purposes of this policy, “smoking” is defined as: (1) any activity included in the definition of smoking under the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act; (2) the burning of tobacco or any other type of material in any type of smoking media or equipment; and (3) using any object or device intended to simulate such activities, including without limitation, electronic cigarettes.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 386.12, it is unlawful for a person under 21 years of age to smoke tobacco or vape in, on, or within 1000 feet of the real property comprising a secondary school; thus, to do so within 1000 feet of the PSC Charter Academy is prohibited

College employees, students, visitors, contractors, and all others are expected to comply with this policy and the Florida Indoor Clean Air Act at all times.

The College president is authorized to develop administrative procedures as necessary to implement this policy, including provisions for notification, signage, exceptions, disciplinary consequences, complaint procedures, and enforcement.
