A student pursuing a vocational certificate program is expected to meet the requirements established by Florida Statutes and State Board of Education Rules. The requirements for each certificate are outlined in the *College Catalog*.

Students pursuing the high school diploma through Pensacola State College’s Collegiate High School are expected to meet the requirements established by Florida Statutes and State Board of Education Rules for the standard high school diploma. Requirements for the diploma will be provided in College publications.

Students successfully completing their declared program requirements will automatically be graduated at the conclusion of the semester in which the requirements are completed. The student’s graduation credential and date will be reflected on the student’s transcript.
