I. Purpose

To promote a safe, healthy, and respectful environment for all students, faculty, staff, and visitors by eliminating exposure to secondhand smoke and tobacco-related pollutants across campus in accordance with the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act.

II. Procedure

- A. Smoking, vaping, and the use of tobacco products are strictly prohibited inside all college buildings and vehicles. The sale, promotion, or distribution of tobacco products is prohibited on campus.
- B. To notify the public of smoking prohibitions, the posting of appropriate signage for no smoking within 50 feet of buildings will be the responsibility of the Facilities Planning and Construction Department.
- C. Cessation of smoking programs will be offered to interested persons by the Office of Staff and Professional Development.
- D. Persons should report infractions of the smoking policy and the Florida Statutes to the Public Safety Department.
