You may meet with an advisor to discuss your particular situation. All courses attempted (college, vocational, and preparatory) are combined to make this determination.

Submitting this form is your request to register in a status of SUSPENSION WAIVER*. Unless other conditions exist preventing registration, you should make immediate arrangements to register for your classes as soon as you submit this form to a registration office on any campus. If you have been academically dismissed, a review by the Student Academic Appeals Committee may be necessary.

REGISTRATION CONDITIONS: You are expected to complete all classes for which you register with grades of "C" or better in each class. College credit and vocational credit students should (1) contact an academic advisor to outline a plan for graduation and (2) visit the Career Connection to take advantage of the services provided by that facility.
