Pensacola State College Emergency Procedures Quick Reference Guide

FIRE OR EXPLOSION

- If a person is on fire, have him/her stop, drop, and roll.
- DO NOT ATTEMPT TO FIGHT FIRE UNLESS YOU ARE PROPERLY TRAINED.
- If you are the first person to learn of a fire or explosion, activate the nearest fire alarm pull station, call **9-1-1**, and then notify Public Safety at **(850) 484-2500**.
- When you hear a fire alarm, evacuate the building immediately.
- Employees should escort students to a safe area. Report any missing students to Public Safety.
- · Wait for directions from Public Safety.

BOMB THREAT

- If you are the first person to learn of a bomb threat, immediately call Public Safety (850) 484-2500. Do not use or allow students to use two-way radios or cell phones.
- If you are the recipient of the threat, keep the caller on the phone and obtain as much information as possible. Document all information.
- Evacuate the building immediately.
- Wait for directions from Public Safety.

SEVERE WEATHER/TORNADO WATCH

- Move outdoor classes/activities indoors.
- Close all windows and doors.
- · Continue class activities. Be alert for further instructions.

TORNADO WARNING

- Cease activities. Move to a safer location in the building, away from windows and doors, and remain calm.
- · Wait for directions from Public Safety or the President's Office.

HAZARDOUS MATERIAL RELEASE

- If you observe or detect a chemical spill or leak, immediately notify Public Safety (850) 484-2500.
- Remove everyone from the immediate area.
- Do not touch or attempt to collect or spread the chemical.
- Wait for directions from Public Safety.
- If a decision is made to SHELTER-IN-PLACE (stay where you are), close all doors and windows, turn off the heating/ventilation/air conditioning system and all fans (if able) to prevent the spread of airborne particles.

ACTIVE SHOOTER

- When you become aware of a gun or weapon on campus or observe an armed suspect, immediately call Public Safety (850) 484-2500, and then call 9-1-1.
- **GET OUT** of the building if you can safely do so.
- If you are unable to get out of a building, HIDE OUT, silence cell phone, close blinds, lock doors, and conceal yourself and students.
- Notify Public Safety (850) 484-2500 as soon as possible and tell them your location.
- Do not approach an armed suspect.
- Only as a last resort should you try to TAKE OUT an armed suspect. Use items around you as weapons in an attempt to overcome the suspect. Notify Public Safety as soon as possible (850) 484-2500.

SEXUAL BATTERY

- If a sexual battery is in progress or just occurred, notify Public Safety at (850) 484-2500, and then call 9-1-1.
- For all reports of sexual battery, immediately notify Public Safety.
- · Never leave the victim alone.
- If the victim has not already done so, do not allow him/her to use the restroom or to "wash up."
- Protect any possible incident location until law enforcement arrives.
- Contact the College Title IX Coordinator at (850) 484-1759.

SUICIDE THREAT/ATTEMPT

- Take the threat seriously. Call Public Safety (850) 484-2500 immediately.
- If the person is armed, immediately evacuate students and yourself.
- If the person is not armed, do not leave them alone.
- Express to the person that you are concerned. If possible, isolate him/her from others.
- If a student mentions that another person is considering suicide but does not want to disclose that information to you, advise him/her to call Public Safety (850) 484-2500, Public Safety/ Silent Witness web page, or the Crisis Hotline at (850) 438-1617.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- Stay with victim. If victim is conscious, ask what the problem is.
 If the victim is unconscious, check for breathing and bleeding.
 Only trained individuals should administer first aid.
- Call **9-1-1** and then call Public Safety (**850**) **484-2500**.
- Keep the victim still and comfortable.
- Search for emergency identification (i.e. ID bracelet).
- · Wait for emergency help to arrive.

ILLEGAL DRUGS

- If you suspect drug dealing, possession, or use is in progress on campus, immediately notify Public Safety (850) 484-2500.
- If a student mentions suspicious or known drug activity by another student, but does not want to disclose the information to you, advise him/her to go to the Public Safety web page and use Silent Witness. It is strictly anonymous and sends a report to Public Safety with the information they provide.

GENERAL EMERGENCY NUMBER

 To report a crime in progress, fire, heart attack, serious injury or any life threatening incident, immediately call 9-1-1 and then notify Public Safety at (850) 484-2500.
