

### **ADA Office**

- Located at the Pensacola Campus Bldg. 6 / Rm. 603 850.484.1637 (Voice/TDD/TTY)
- ADA services include:
  - Assistance in gaining admission to the college.
  - Assistance with course selections.
  - Classroom accommodations such as notetakers, sign language interpreters, and special seating.
  - Learning aids such as taped materials, Braille, or enlarged materials, and adaptive equipment.
  - Individual instruction services.
  - Testing accommodations such as isolated testing, extended time for testing, etc.

## How to use VA Benefits

Anyone using veteran Benefits needs to do the following:

PLEASE NOTE: entire process can be done via email

- Provide VSO with a copy of Certificate of Eligibility
- Fill out Statement of Understanding
- Submit Prior Credit (PC) from High School, College, or Military

Each semester, students using VA benefits need to submit a VA certification request via their PSC Workday account.

Start by accessing MyPSC (https://myapplications.microsoft.com/). MyPSC is also conveniently located at the top of the Pensacola State College website, https://www.pensacolastate.edu/.

#### Off Campus

- Access MyPSC.
- Login with your full PSC email address and your current password.
  - Your email address is:

    @students.pensacolastate.edu
  - The default password is LoginYYYYMMDD!
    - Replace YYYY with your birth year, MM with your birth month, and DD with your birthday. (Ex. If your birthday is March 5, 2001 then your password is Login20010305!)
    - The ! (exclamation point) is part of the password and must be included.
  - Make sure to complete additional information needed for self-service password reset.
    - DO NOT CANCEL PAST THIS STEP

#### On Campus

- To log in to a computer on campus, your username is just the first part of your email address, before the @student pensacolastate.edu. It's not your full email address.
- Access MyPSC.
- Login with your full PSC email address and your current password.

MyPSC is where to go to access all of your PSC applications, such as Outlook (PirateMail), Word, Workday, Canvas, Teams, PowerPoint, and more!

- · Outlook Access all your PSC emails.
- Canvas Access to all eLearning courses at PSC.
- Workday Register for class, view your schedule, view your grades, add or drop a class, check your progress toward degree completion, view pending financial aid awards, view tuition and fees, pay your bill
  - o Workday Mobile Access
    - Download the Workday mobile application from the App Store or Google Play
    - Organization ID = pensacolastate
    - Login with your full PSC email address and your current password.



## Other Resources: (Residency)

#### Residency Classification:


• If you are at least 24 years of age by the first day of classes of your first term, you are considered independent and you will be the CLAIMANT for residency. You will need to provide proof of legal residency as covered in Step 3.

Students who are under the age of 24, but meet one of the criteria below are considered independent and will be the CLAIMANT

- The student is married. Copy of marriage license required
- The student can provide documentation that he/she claimed independence under the federal income tax code and that he/she earned at least 51% of the cost of attendance as determined by PSC's Financial Aid Office. Copy of your most recent IRS tax transcript or federal income tax return required.
- The student is on active duty in the United States Armed Forces or is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces. Official military documentation or DD214 required.
- Both of the student's parents are deceased or the student is, or was until age 18, a ward/dependent of the court. Copy of court documents required.
- For Non-U.S. Citizens: In order to qualify as a resident for tuition purposes, you must be a lawful permanent resident alien, legal alien granted indefinite stay by Homeland Security, or must possess an approved Visa Category. ## Other Resources: (Student ID & Car Decal)

- 1. Bring a copy of your class schedule, vehicle registration, and valid photo ID to the <u>Public Safety Department on any campus to get your free parking decal</u>
- 2. Upload a passport-style photo of yourself in Workday for approval. Once approved, this photo will be used to print your Student ID card. You may also bring a copy of your class schedule and a valid photo ID to the Admissions Center on the Pensacola campus to get your ID card. You may pick up your card on campus or request that it be mailed to your home address.


