Sole Source Announcement

Your protest must be in writing and describe the basis for the protest. Please submit your protest, to cboatwright@pensacolastate.edu and include the words "PROTEST OF NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT" (reference the contractor's name that is subject of your protest) and your company name on the subject line.
